Bouncy Castle Assembly and Inflation Instructions

Please Respect the Equipment we provide and the Sports Hall itself, and leave it how you would wish to find it,

Please do not take food and drink into the main hall, or have it on any of our play equipment.

Please make sure to take All Food Items and Waste Home with you

Please make a copy of this document and refer to it throughout the assembly and inflation of the bouncy castle in order to not cause damage to yourself or the castle throughout the inflation and deflation process

Bouncy Castle Inflation & Use Instructions

The Bouncy Castle is located on a trolley in the storage cupboard
Lay the castle out at the northern end of the Sports Hall and fully unfold it

Ensure that the two zips are **fully** closed **prior** to inflation



Attach the Blower to the Bouncy Castle and tighten the strap
Ensure that the Bouncy Castle's tube is straight as shown in this image,
Do **not** tie any knots in the strap



Plug the blower in using the extension lead provided and switch on the blower, within a few minutes the , the blower will need to be left on while the castle is in use, please make sure the extension lead is trailed safely that it will not be a trip hazard or pulled out of the wall during use of the Bouncy Castle



Once Inflated the Bouncy Castle will look like this



Before allowing children on the Bouncy Castle please review and abide by the Safety instructions printed on it, these are to prevent injury. Do not allow any children to use the castle without being supervised and attended by a responsible adults/member of your team

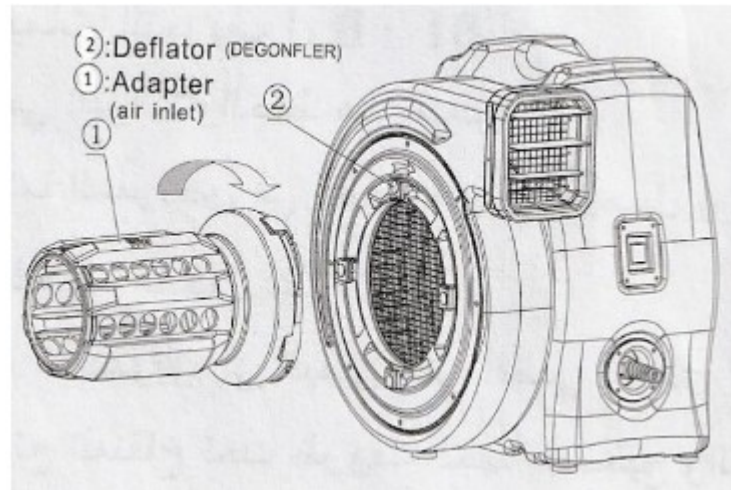


Once the castle has been set up and safety instructions reviewed, please spread out the provided mats the castle to protect users from harm if they fall off the castle, that mats are there for your own safety and should always be used, an example of how they can be laid out is the following



Bouncy Castle Deflation

Please Deflate and back up the Bouncy Castle to the same state as you found it by following these steps, please refer to this image of the blower for these instructions



- 1) Switch off the Blower (2)
- 2) Disconnect the Bouncy Castle from the Blower
- 3) Connect the Adapter (1) to the air inlet on the Blower (2)
- 4) Make sure the Blower's (2) notch positions align with the adaptor
- 5) Rotate the Adaptor (1) Clockwise until it locks into position, you will hear a click when it is fully locked into place.
- 6) Connect the Bouncy Castle's tube to the Adaptor (1)
- 7) Switch on the Blower, if all is connected properly, the Bouncy Castle should fully deflate in a few minutes.
- 8) Once Deflated, open both zips and fold the bouncy castle back up, ensuring that you squeeze any air out through the zip holes

Once this is done, please return the Bouncy Castle, Blower, Mats and anything else you used to the storage cupboard tidily and in the same way you would want to find it
